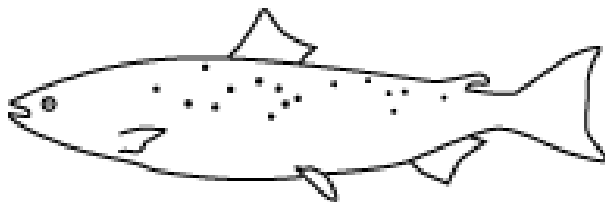

Science and Literature

Students should note that the green water means there is too much algae. Too much algae may mean there are chemicals in the water.

Thinking About Foreshadowing
